Tickets for the Fall Festival are on sale today! The cost is .25 per ticket. Tickets will be used to purchase food and participate in games and activities.

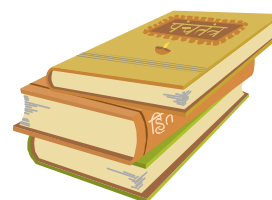
