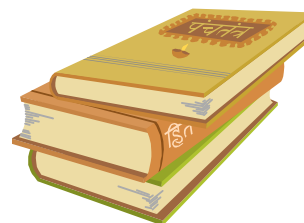
6<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents,
